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NEW OPERATING SYSTEM DEPLOYED

NEWTIN IMPLEMENTATION

Blue Stakes Notification Center deployed a new ticket entry operating system called NEWTIN during the month of June 2006.

NEWTIN had been scheduled for implementation during the 1st quarter of 2006 but was delayed until the end of the 2nd quarter of this year due to additional programming modifications that were required that had not been anticipated.

One of the major features the new system will provide Association members with is the ability to select notification areas with shape files or polygons versus the 15 second latitude / longitude grids used by the Center since 1999. This new feature should aid Association members in reducing the number of over notifications they receive.

TRAINING SCHEDULE

Remote Ticket Entry (RTE) and Quick Ticket (QT) WEB application users

Remote Access for Members (RAM) users and Association members who would like to incorporate polygons or shape files into their notification areas versus grids

The Association is funded by participating member utilities through the following fees established by the Board of Trustees:

MEMBERSHIP FEE - \$50.00

This fee is charged per receiver site annually and appears on billing invoices mailed in January of each year.

This fee is charged per notification transmission based upon the following delivery types:

- Modem Delivery - \$0.73**
- Email Delivery - \$0.95**
- Voice Delivery - \$2.50**
- Emergency Voice - \$1.50 Delivery**

PENDING INCREASE IN ASSOCIATION FEES

It is anticipated with the implementation of the new operating system providing members the ability to reduce over notification by selecting notification areas using shape files or polygons versus grids, that the Association may experience a significant reduction in notification fee revenue.

A reduction in notification fee revenue will have a negative impact on the Center's ability to meet its operating and maintenance expense required to provide continued levels of customer service that both

excavators and Association members have come to expect.

Pending the outcome of the impact notification areas selected by polygons versus grids in the new system will have on the Center's ability to generate adequate revenue may require the Board of Trustees to address a change in billing practices or an increase in the cost of notification fees.
